

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2. CERTIFICATION INFORMATION

Description of product certification

The subject of this Climate Active Carbon Neutral Product certification is a new product offering by the Pacific Blue Retail brand, consisting of gas sold to its customers. Currently, the Pacific Blue Retail brand has not introduced this gas product to the market, as it is undergoing a strategic product review. The launch of this gas product is scheduled to occur after the completion of the review, expected in 2024.

The responsible entity for this product certification is Pacific Blue Retail Pty Ltd (trading as Pacific Blue Retail), ABN 43 155 908 839.

Description of business

Pacific Blue Retail Pty Ltd is an electricity and gas retailing company, selling energy products to customers under the Pacific Blue Retail and Tango Energy brands. Climate Active certified carbon neutral products are available through its Pacific Blue Retail brand for all residential and small business customers.

3.EMISSIONS BOUNDARY

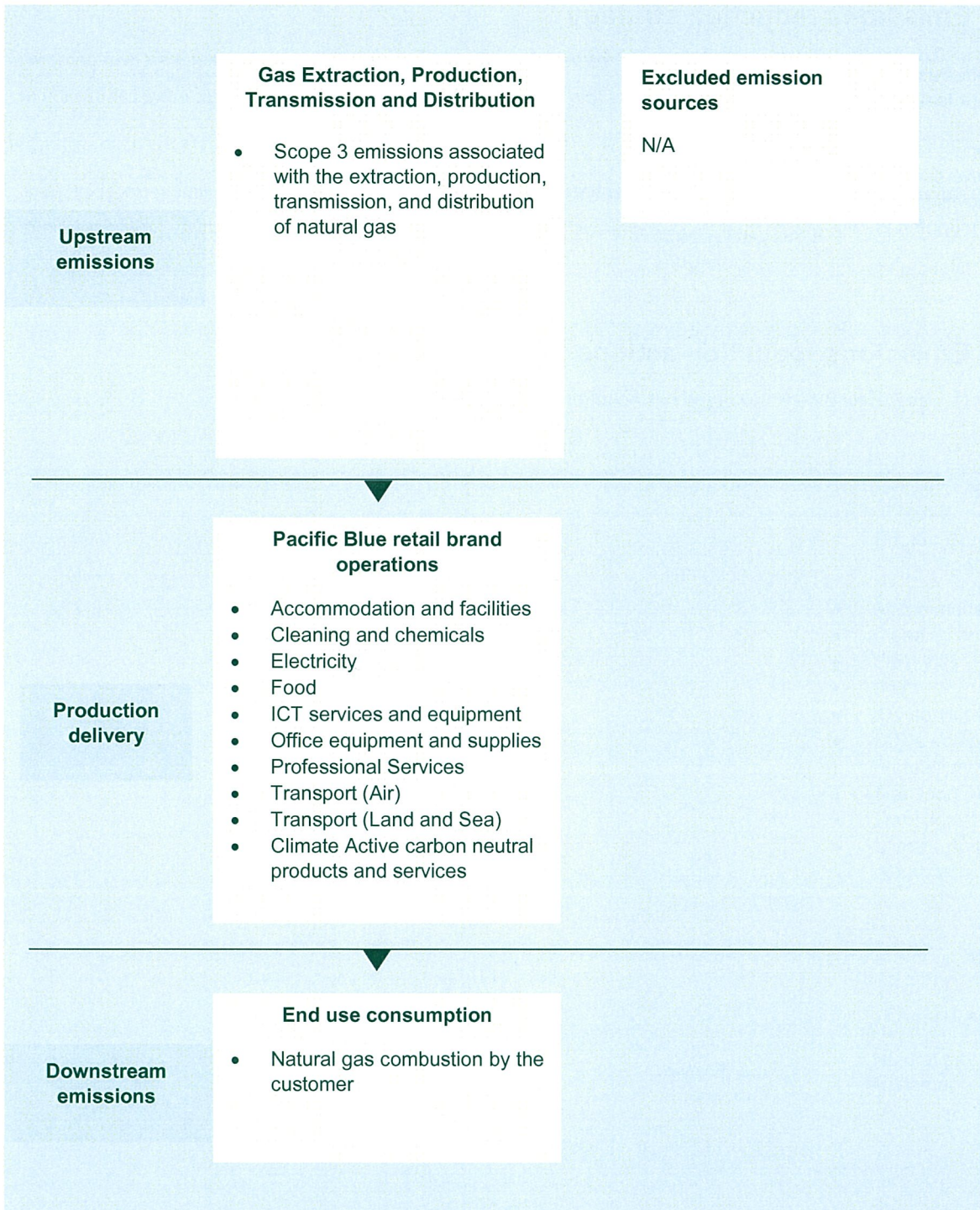

APPENDIX D: OUTSIDE EMISSION BOUNDARY

2. **Influence** The responsible entity could influence emissions reduction from a particular source.
3. **Risk** The emissions from a particular source contribute to the responsible entity's greenhouse gas risk exposure.
4. **Stakeholders** The emissions from a particular source are deemed relevant by key stakeholders.
5. **Outsourcing** The emissions are from outsourced activities that were previously undertaken by the responsible entity or from outsourced activities that are typically undertaken within the boundary for comparable products or services.
